During a stellar 21-season NHL career, Bruce Hood officiated 1,033 regular season games as well as 157 playoff contests, three All-Star Games and three Canada Cup tournaments. Bruce also has the designation of being the last official to work in all Original Six arenas. He retired from officiating after the 1984 playoffs. In 1969, Hood was instrumental in the formation of the NHL Officials' Association. Bruce has written two books: 'Calling the Shots' (1988) and 'The Good of the Game' (1999).
