



### **MATHIEU SCHNEIDER**

Stanley Cup champion Mathieu Schneider has joined the Road Hockey To Conquer Cancer team! Mathieu Schneider was drafted by the Montreal Canadiens in 1987, and made his NHL debut on the opening night of the 1987-88 season. While playing with Montreal, Mathieu was a member of the Stanley Cup championship in 1993. He was traded to the Islanders during the 1994-95 season, and appeared in the NHL All-Star Game in 1996.

That March, Mathieu was traded to the Toronto Maple Leafs. Early in the 1998-99 season, he was again traded, this time to the New York Rangers. The smooth-skating Schneider joined the Columbus Blue Jackets in the 2000 NHL Expansion Draft, but a month later, signed with the Los Angeles Kings. After participating in the 2003 NHL All-Star Game, Schneider was dealt to Detroit's Red Wings, where he collected a career-high 21 goals and 59 points in 2005-06. He signed as a free agent with the Anaheim Ducks in 2006-07, joined the Atlanta Thrashers in 2008-09 but was traded to the Canadiens in February 2009. That summer, Mathieu signed with the Vancouver Canucks, but concluded the 2009-10 season with the Phoenix Coyotes. Today, the much-travelled Schneider is employed by the National Hockey League Players' Association.
