Paralympic gold medalist Paul Rosen has joined the Road Hockey To Conquer Cancer team!

Paul Rosen suffered a leg injury as a youth that ultimately resulted in amputation of his lower leg at the age of 39. He turned to sledge hockey, and after try-outs, made the Canadian National Sledge Hockey Team as a 41-

year-old rookie goaltender. The team played in the 2002 and 2006 Winter Paralympics, taking the gold medal in Turin in 2006. The medal was stolen during a public appearance, but Don Cherry interceded and after asking for the thief to simply drop the medal in a nearby mailbox, astonishingly, it was! Paul got back his gold medal.
